### **MSc requirements for CIMA members**

CIMA members only need to complete the professional thesis to obtain the MSc.

#### **Course information**

There are two intakes per year – February and October.

The deadline for admission is mid-September for the October intake, and mid-January for the February intake.

#### **Professional thesis**

The final assessment is based on the submission of a professional thesis. A professional thesis is a piece of academic and empirical research in the field of specialisation and is supervised by a member of faculty throughout the year.

A panel made up of the programme director, supervisor and faculty marks the professional thesis.
