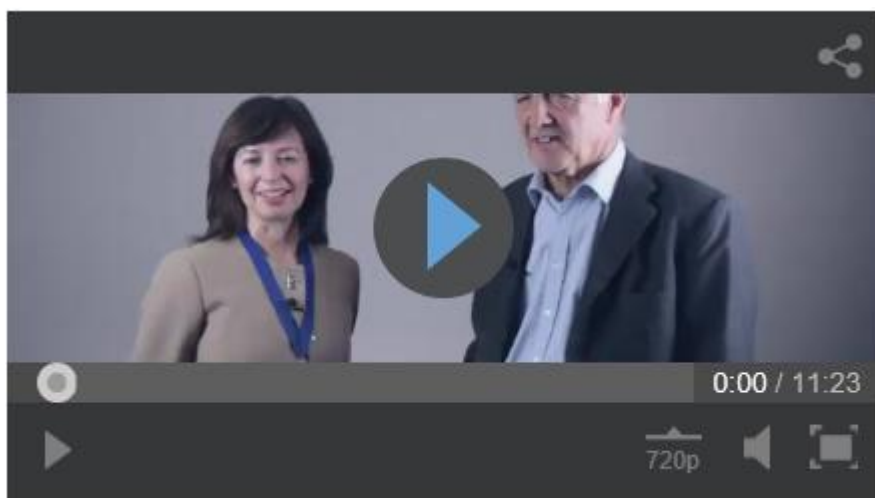
Fantastic news for CIMA students:
