

CIMA Investigation Committee - 18 June 2019
Mr Vladislav Ulasevics Registered Student of London E15, UK

The Investigation Committee found a prima facie case of misconduct against Mr Vladislav Ulasevics in that whilst a Registered Student with CIMA he had made false declarations on his CV which he submitted for a freelance consulting position. He claimed to be CIMA Dip MA when in fact he had not completed the Operational Level of the CIMA Professional Qualification and was not entitled to use the letters CIMA Dip MA.

The Committee was satisfied that Mr Ulasevics's actions were dishonest and therefore in breach of the integrity and professional behaviour requirements of the Code of Ethics. The Committee therefore determined that his actions could amount to misconduct as alleged. Mr Ulasevics agreed by way of a consent order that he receive the sanction of a severe reprimand and a contribution to CIMA's costs of £456.00.
