Re: CIMA (Chartered Institute of Management Accountants) Qualification registration with SAQA (South African Qualifications Authority)

In order to qualify with the Chartered Institute of Management Accountants (CIMA) as a Chartered Management Accountant, students have to complete the CIMA exams, typically over a 3 year period and in addition gain 3 years relevant practical experience. The practical experience covers 3 areas, specified by CIMA. Details of the practical experience requirements can be found on our website at www.cimaglobal.com

The Chartered Management Accountant qualification is registered with the South African Qualifications Authority (SAQA) at Level 7. The SAQA NQF registration number is 20400. The minimum credits attached to this are 930.

The CIMA Advanced Diploma in Management Accounting (Managerial level) is registered with SAQA at Level 6. The SAQA NQF registration number is 24406. The minimum credits attached to this are 240.

The CIMA Certificate in Business Accounting (Certificate level) is registered with SAQA at Level 5. The SAQA NQF registration number is 24418. The minimum credits attached to this are 120.

All 3 qualifications are registered learnerships with the Department of Labour and FASSET.
